REPORT TO APCM ON ST MARY'S SPEEN UP TO DATE FINANCIAL POSITION

It's been a very odd year for us all, and also for our church finances.

Lettings and fund-raising (remember the Christmas Bazaar?) have all but dried up. Fees from weddings were £1,700 last year, nil this, though we've had a fair number of funerals and memorial fees.

The good news is, most of our regular supporters have maintained or even increased their giving, so, despite numbers on Sundays currently about half our usual attendance (nil from end March to July) our giving is only about £2,000 down.

Of course we have had lower costs (eg no organists, little electricity), and we also had a refund of overpaid electricity charges (estimated usage was way in advance of actual) which brought us in some £2,400 in August! As a result, we expect to have a deficit of less than £1,000 this year.

And my first shot at next year's budget suggests we will see that year through as well. Praise the Lord!!

And most importantly:

Thank you SO MUCH to those who have continued to support St M's financially so generously and so faithfully. It has been a tremendous encouragement to me, and to your PCC, in a situation where I was wondering how we were going to meet our basic but sizeable everyday bills such as insurance and clergy expenses. I felt increasingly humbled. There will, of course, be full accounts for our APCM. John Hughesdon
